Notice of Public Hearing:

Draft Environmental Impact Statement for New Runways and Related Improvements

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is issuing this notice to advise the public that a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) incorporating a Draft Air Quality General Conformity Determination (DGCD) and Draft Section 106 Historic Resources Report are available for public review at a variety of locations. The DEIS presents a comprehensive analysis of the potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed development of two new air carrier runways, terminal facilities, and other related improvements at Washington Dulles International Airport (IAD).
